Daily COVID-19 online dashboard reactivated

The daily online dashboard that Indiana State University uses to inform the campus about active COVID-19 cases is back in operation today.

“With the increased density of the population on campus every day, it is appropriate to return to a daily dashboard for the fall semester,” said Vice President for University Engagement Nancy Rogers. “Our goal is to be transparent with clear and timely information about the presence of COVID-19 on campus.”

The dashboard reports the number of students and employees who are in isolation or quarantine because of COVID-19. It is updated by noon on weekdays, based on the previous day’s numbers at 11:59 p.m.

Those in isolation have confirmed positive cases of COVID-19. Those in quarantine had “close contact” with someone who is positive. ISU is using the definition of “close contact” provided by the Centers for Disease Control and the Indiana State Department of Health.

ISU’s dashboard follows privacy laws and does not reveal information that would make someone individually identifiable. The dashboard only reflects information known as of the date and time listed.
