Biology, M.S.

The University offers a master of science (M.S.) in biology with or without thesis. The graduate programs in biology provide the student with a strong background needed to pursue a career in college or university teaching and research, government and industrial research, state wildlife agencies, and in many other related areas. Whereas at the undergraduate level, students are engaged in a broad, general program of study in biology, at the graduate level the program is specialized to fit the individual needs and plans of each student.

College of Graduate and Professional Studies Requirements

- **Application:** indstate.edu/apply
- **\$45.00 application fee** (nonrefundable). Payable by Visa, MasterCard, check or money order payable to Indiana State University (include SSN or student ID). Applications cannot be evaluated until the fee has been received. State students returning within two years from their last enrollment will be exempt from the fee.
- **Official transcripts** for all institutions attended (undergraduate and graduate) must be sent directly from the school attended to Graduate Admissions. E-transcripts should be sent to admissions@indstate.edu. Indiana State University graduates are not required to submit transcripts.
- **Additional admission materials and requirements.** Please see the specific program requirements below.

Department Requirements

To ensure priority consideration for assistantship funding for **fall admission apply by February 1** and for **spring admission by October 15**.

- Three letters of recommendation
- Name of faculty member chosen as faculty mentor

- Graduate Record Examination* (GRE)
