MASTER'S PROGRAMS

Clinical Mental Health Counseling, M.S.

The University offers a master of science (M.S.) in clinical mental health counseling. The clinical mental health counseling program is designed to provide the trainee with the understanding, training, and experience necessary for entry and successful participation, and development in the field. Students will be prepared for licensure as a mental health counselor in the State of Indiana. This program is primarily intended for persons who wish to engage in counseling in settings such as community mental health agencies, student counseling centers, correctional facilities, or other mental agencies.

College of Graduate and Professional Studies Requirements

- **Application:** indstate.edu/apply
- **\$45.00 application fee** (nonrefundable). Payable by Visa, MasterCard, check or money order payable to Indiana State University (include SSN or student ID). Applications cannot be evaluated until the fee has been received. State students returning within two years from their last enrollment will be exempt from the fee.
- **Official transcripts** for all institutions attended (undergraduate and graduate) must be sent directly from the school attended to Graduate Admissions. E-transcripts should be sent to admissions@indstate.edu. Indiana State University graduates are not required to submit transcripts.
- **Additional admission materials and requirements.** Please see the specific program requirements below.

Department Requirements

Application **deadline is December 16** to be guaranteed first consideration for summer admission.

- Undergraduate grade point average (GPA) requirement of 2.75 or better on a 4.0 scale
- 3.0 GPA on all courses taken at the graduate level
- Minimum of 12 credits in the behavioral sciences at undergraduate level
- Have scores on the general tests of the Graduate Record Examination* (GRE) or the Miller Analogies Test (MAT).
- Three letters of recommendation
- Professional resume
- Application for admission Clinical Mental Health Counseling
