- **\$45.00 application fee** (nonrefundable). Payable by Visa, MasterCard, check or money order payable to Indiana State University (include SSN or student ID). Applications cannot be evaluated until the fee has been received. State students returning within two years from their last enrollment will be exempt from the fee.
- **Official transcripts** for all institutions attended (undergraduate and graduate) must be sent directly from the school attended to Graduate Admissions. E-transcripts should be sent to [admissions@indstate.edu](mailto:admissions@indstate.edu). Indiana State University graduates are not required to submit transcripts.
- **Additional admission materials and requirements.** Please see the specific program requirements below.

### Department Requirements

Applications are accepted anytime prior to the start of fall or spring semester. For full consideration for fall graduate assistantship positions applications must be complete by **March 10**.

- Two letters of recommendation
- Graduate Record Examination\* (GRE) scores
- Response to departmental questions
