Career and Technical Education, M.S.

The career and technical education program continues the development of professional and technical knowledge of persons teaching in the discipline. Persons enrolled in this degree teach in secondary schools, community colleges, and career centers. This is not an initial teacher licensure program. However, applicants that have passed the state-approved teacher licensing tests may be eligible for teacher licensure through the Indiana Department of Education.

College of Graduate and Professional Studies Requirements

- **Application:** indstate.edu/apply
- **\$45.00 application fee** (nonrefundable). Payable by Visa, MasterCard, check or money order payable to Indiana State University (include SSN or student ID). Applications cannot be evaluated until the fee has been received. State students returning within two years from their last enrollment will be exempt from the fee.
- **Official transcripts** for all institutions attended (undergraduate and graduate) must be sent directly from the school attended to Graduate Admissions. E-transcripts should be sent to admissions@indstate.edu. Indiana State University graduates are not required to submit transcripts.
