College of Graduate and Professional Studies Requirements

- **Application:** indstate.edu/apply
- **\$45.00 application fee** (nonrefundable). Payable by Visa, MasterCard, check or money order payable to Indiana State University (include SSN or student ID). Applications cannot be evaluated until the fee has been received. State students returning within two years from their last enrollment will be exempt from the fee.
- **Official transcripts** for all institutions attended (undergraduate and graduate) must be sent directly from the school attended to Graduate Admissions. E-transcripts should be sent to admissions@indstate.edu. Indiana State University graduates are not required to submit transcripts.
- **Additional admission materials and requirements.** Please see the specific program requirements below.

Department Requirements

Application deadline for **fall admission is June 1**. Application deadline for **spring admission is November 1**.

- Three letters of recommendation
- Curriculum vitae/resume
- Personal statement—Part of the statement must identify areas of research interest and justify two department faculty that might be suited to serve on your research committee.
- Student must complete a master's level research methods course with a B or better prior to registration.
- Student must complete a master's level statistics course with a B or better prior to registration.
- Graduate Record Examination* (GRE) scores required for students with graduate GPAs lower than 3.5
