## English, M.A.

Graduate programs in English at Indiana State University provide opportunities for two concentrations in English studies—British and American literature and writing. Course work is offered in British and American literature, general and comparative literature, rhetoric and composition, and creative writing.

- **\$45.00 application fee** (nonrefundable). Payable by Visa, MasterCard, check or money order payable to Indiana State University (include SSN or student ID). Applications cannot be evaluated until the fee has been received. State students returning within two years from their last enrollment will be exempt from the fee.
- **Official transcripts** for all institutions attended (undergraduate and graduate) must be sent directly from the school attended to Graduate Admissions. E-transcripts should be sent to [admissions@indstate.edu](mailto:admissions@indstate.edu). Indiana State University graduates are not required to submit transcripts.
