## History, M.A. or M.S.

The Master's degree program in the Department of History is designed to fulfill a variety of academic and professional objectives and is offered both on campus and online. The program facilitates preparation for entry into doctoral programs in history and for teaching at the university, community college, and secondary levels. Graduate work in history also provides an excellent background for careers in law, theology, business, government service, and writing, and for specialized work as a museum curator, librarian, archivist, editor, historic site specialist, and research historian.

- **\$45.00 application fee** (nonrefundable). Payable by Visa, MasterCard, check or money order payable to Indiana State University (include SSN or student ID). Applications cannot be evaluated until the fee has been received. State students returning within two years from their last enrollment will be exempt from the fee.
- **Official transcripts** for all institutions attended (undergraduate and graduate) must be sent directly from the school attended to Graduate Admissions. E-transcripts should be sent to [admissions@indstate.edu](mailto:admissions@indstate.edu). Indiana State University graduates are not required to submit transcripts.
- **Additional admission materials and requirements.** Please see the specific program requirements below.

### Department Requirements

**Application deadlines** are **September 15 for spring** and **April 15 for fall**.

- Non-native English speakers should submit TOEFL score of 79 or above
- A personal statement addressing the applicant's experience with history and/or closely related field, areas of historical interest, and reasons for applying to ISU's Master's program.
- A writing sample, preferably a research paper that demonstrates ability in historical research and analysis.
- Two letters of recommendation, preferably from those with experience in history.
