College of Graduate and Professional Studies Requirements

- **Application:** indstate.edu/apply
- **\$45.00 application fee** (nonrefundable). Payable by Visa, MasterCard, check or money order payable to Indiana State University (include SSN or student ID). Applications cannot be evaluated until the fee has been received. State students returning within two years from their last enrollment will be exempt from the fee.
- **Official transcripts** for all institutions attended (undergraduate and graduate) must be sent directly from the school attended to Graduate Admissions. E-transcripts should be sent to admissions@indstate.edu. Indiana State University graduates are not required to submit transcripts.
- **Additional admission materials and requirements.** Please see the specific program requirements below.

Department Requirements

Students are encouraged to apply early to ensure admission. Applications received after the following deadlines may be “wait-listed” pending an opening: **fall semester by June 1, spring semester by November 1, and summer semester by April 1.**

- Two letters of recommendation
- Statement of purpose
- Minimum grade point average (GPA) 2.7 in undergraduate studies
- Minimum grade point average (GPA) 3.0 in graduate studies
