- **\$45.00 application fee** (nonrefundable). Payable by Visa, MasterCard, check or money order payable to Indiana State University (include SSN or student ID). Applications cannot be evaluated until the fee has been received. State students returning within two years from their last enrollment will be exempt from the fee.
- **Official transcripts** for all institutions attended (undergraduate and graduate) must be sent directly from the school attended to Graduate Admissions. E-transcripts should be sent to [admissions@indstate.edu](mailto:admissions@indstate.edu). Indiana State University graduates are not required to submit transcripts.
- **Additional admission materials and requirements.** Please see the specific program requirements below.

#### Department Requirements

**Complete your application by February 1** in order to be guaranteed full consideration. Applications received after February 1, will be considered if openings are available.

- Minimum grade point average (GPA) 2.7 in undergraduate studies or 3.0 in the last 60 credit hours based on a 4.0 scale.
- Department application
- Prerequisites: six courses in social and behavioral sciences, and one statistics course
- Professional resume
- Statement of purpose
- Self disclosure statement
- Three letters of recommendation with the M.S.W. summary evaluation
- Criminal background check
