### Occupational Safety Management, M.A or M.S

The University offers a master of arts (M.A.) and master of science (M.S.) in occupational safety management. The occupational safety management specialization is intended for persons interested in achieving managerial positions in industrial safety. The curriculum provides a broad foundation of theoretical and practical knowledge of safety administration. It emphasizes the skills and methodologies of problem-solving and analysis that are critical for sophisticated planners and managers in the private and public sectors of occupational management. Content areas include systems safety, human factors engineering, program management and evaluation, safety law, and policy analysis. Employment opportunities are usually found in industry; federal, state, and local government agencies; insurance companies; the military; labor unions; consulting firms; and health care facilities.
