- **Application:** [indstate.edu/apply](http://indstate.edu/apply)
- **\$45.00 application fee** (nonrefundable). Payable by Visa, MasterCard, check or money order payable to Indiana State University (include SSN or student ID). Applications cannot be evaluated until the fee has been received. State students returning within two years from their last enrollment will be exempt from the fee.
- **Official transcripts** for all institutions attended (undergraduate and graduate) must be sent directly from the school attended to Graduate Admissions. E-transcripts should be sent to [admissions@indstate.edu](mailto:admissions@indstate.edu). Indiana State University graduates are not required to submit transcripts.
- **Additional admission materials and requirements.** Please see the specific program requirements below.

#### Department Requirements

Applications for the clinical doctoral (Psy.D.) program will be **accepted between September 1 and December 5** for the upcoming fall cohort. Applications and application materials received after will not be considered for admission.

- 24 undergraduate hours in psychology
- Minimum grade point average (GPA) 3.0
- Graduate Record Examination\* (GRE) scores (*150 verbal and quantitative/writing 4.0 or better*)
- Three letters of reference
- Personal statement
- Curriculum vitae
- Department application
