- **Application:** [indstate.edu/apply](http://indstate.edu/apply)
- **\$45.00 application fee** (nonrefundable). Payable by Visa, MasterCard, check or money order payable to Indiana State University (include SSN or student ID). Applications cannot be evaluated until the fee has been received. State students returning within two years from their last enrollment will be exempt from the fee.
- **Official transcripts** for all institutions attended (undergraduate and graduate) must be sent directly from the school attended to Graduate Admissions. E-transcripts should be sent to [admissions@indstate.edu](mailto:admissions@indstate.edu). Indiana State University graduates are not required to submit transcripts.

#### Department Requirements

Complete your application for **fall admission by January 15** and for **spring admission by November 1**.

- Graduate Record Examination\* (GRE) scores (*verbal 153/quantitative 144*)
- Three letters of recommendation
- Personal statement/letter of intent
- Curriculum vitae
- Supplemental documents
