

Adding SoftChalk Lessons to Blackboard

SoftChalk is an online platform that allows users to create interactive lessons that can be added directly to Blackboard courses. Faculty have **three options** when adding a SoftChalk lesson to Blackboard:

- 1 Use a hyperlink, which does NOT track student progress or automatically score the lesson.
- **Embed** the lesson, which does NOT track student progress or automatically score the lesson.
- 3 Use the LTI link, which will track student progress and automatically score the lesson in the Grade Center.

OPTION #1: Add the Lesson with a Hyperlink

- 1. Navigate to the content area in your Blackboard course where you would like to add the SoftChalk lesson.
- 2. Hover over the Build Content button and select the Web Link option.
- 3. Type a title in the Name box.
- 4. For the URL, paste the hyperlink that is automatically created and provided in SoftChalk.
 - a. To retrieve the hyperlink of a lesson you created or is openly available:
 - i. Log into your **SoftChalk** account.
 - ii. Find the desired lesson (either in My Content > Lessons or in the <u>SoftChalk Share Repository</u>) and click on the title.
 - iii. Scroll down to the lesson's information, which can be found below the preview window.
 - iv. Copy the hyperlink from the Hyperlink box.
 - b. To retrieve the hyperlink of a lesson you did not create, contact the owner and request the link.
- 5. In the Description text editor box, add a description detailing what students should do or expect in the lesson.
- 6. Select additional settings such as whether the lesson should open in a new window, whether the number of views should be tracked, and whether the SoftChalk lesson should have availability dates.
- 7. Click Submit.

OPTION #2: Embed the Lesson

- 1. Navigate to the content area in your Blackboard course where you would like to add the SoftChalk lesson.
- 2. Hover over the Build Content button and select the Item option.
- 3. Type a title in the Name box.
- 4. In the Text editor box, add a description detailing what students should do or expect in the lesson. Make sure your mouse is at the end of your narrative before moving onto the next step.
- 5. Click on the Source Code icon (<>) in the text editor and paste in the embed code.
 - a. To retrieve the embed code of a lesson you created or is openly available:
 - i. Log into your **SoftChalk** account.
 - ii. Find the desired lesson (either in My Content > Lessons or in the <u>SoftChalk Share Repository</u>) and click on the title.
 - iii. Scroll down to the lesson's information, which can be found below the preview window.
 - iv. Copy the embed code from the Embed box.
 - b. To retrieve the embed code of a lesson you did not create, contact the owner and request the code.
- 6. Click Save to return to the normal text editor.
- 7. Select additional settings such as whether the number of views should be tracked and whether the SoftChalk lesson should have availability dates.
- 8. Click Submit.

OPTION #3: Add the Lesson with a LTI Link and Track Student Progress

- 1. Navigate to the content area in your Blackboard course where you would like to add the SoftChalk lesson.
- 2. Hover over the Build Content button and select the Web Link option.
- 3. Type a title in the Name box.
- 4. For the URL, paste the LTI link that is automatically created and provided in SoftChalk.
 - a. To retrieve the LTI link of a lesson you created:
 - i. Log into your SoftChalk account.
 - ii. Find the desired lesson (in My Content > Lessons) and click on the title.
 - iii. Scroll down to the lesson's information, which can be found below the preview window.
 - iv. Copy the LTI link from the LTI Link box.
 - b. To retrieve the LTI link of a lesson you did not create, contact the owner and request the link.
- 5. Click the box next to "This link is to a Tool Provider."
- 6. Click on the circle next to YES by Enable Evaluation.
- 7. Select a value for Points Possible. If you select a value for the Grade Center that is more or fewer than the points for the SoftChalk lesson, Blackboard will automatically adjust the scores to reflect your desired point value.
- 8. If desired, select a due date for the lesson.
- 9. In the Description text editor box, add a description detailing what students should do or expect in the lesson.
- 10. Select additional settings such as whether the lesson should open in a new window, whether the number of views should be tracked, and whether the SoftChalk lesson should have availability dates.
- 11. Click Submit.
