Midwest Consortium Scholarship

For consideration, candidates must be residents of Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, or Wisconsin and have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. All incoming graduate students, effective Fall 2009, who are admitted to the University will be automatically considered for this scholarship. No additional application is required.

- 1. Reduced tuition rate (see <u>academic fees</u> for current rate)
- 2. Renewable
- 3. A limited number of Midwest Consortium Scholarships are awarded each year.
- 4. Most graduate degree programs are eligible.*
- 5. Full-time enrollment (9 credits or more)
- * Students pursuing nursing programs are not eligible.
- * Students pursuing doctoral degrees are not eligible.
- * Students pursuing M.S. degree in Occupational Therapy and Physician Assistant Studies are not eligible.
