## **Provost announces updated COVID-19 vaccine and testing requirements for experiential learning activities**

Interim Provost Christopher Olsen today announced new COVID-19 vaccine or testing requirements for experiential learning and community engagement activities at Indiana State University. Details of the requirements and processes can be found at this [link](#).

Starting on Oct. 1, individuals participating in certain experiential learning and community engagement activities will be required to provide either proof of COVID-19 vaccination or proof of a negative COVID-19 test.

ISU students participating in University-sponsored travel will be required to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken within 72 hours of the start of travel or proof of vaccination.

Students and instructors participating in select experiential learning activities will be required to provide either proof of vaccination or weekly/semi-weekly proof of a negative COVID-19 test. Semi-weekly testing is required for all students participating in theater productions and all students and instructors in the ISU Flight Academy this semester.

Proof of vaccination or weekly testing is required for:

- Students who have matriculated into the clinical, practicum, or internship phases of a clinical program.
- Pre-service teacher education majors, including secondary education majors, with school-based experiences.
- Student instructors in the Community School of the Arts
- Sycamore Community Work participants
- Participants of club sports with close contact

“These new requirements are designed to keep all students, employees, and the campus safer, and also to make sure that we are being a responsible community

partner in the Wabash Valley,” Olsen said. “We all want to preserve the full range of classes and experiential learning opportunities that ISU is known for, and these requirements will help us do that.”
