#### **Staff Council Elections**

Nominations are now being accepted for staff members to serve as representatives for the 2023-2026 term. There are 10 full term and 1 partial term positions. Each full term is a 3-year commitment with responsibilities that include participation in monthly general council meetings, standing committee meetings, and related council business. Bylaws detailing responsibilities and council procedures can be found on the ISU Staff Council website.

Eligible persons include all ISU non-exempt, non-exempt professional, and exempt Staff who have successfully completed their initial introductory period (90 days) with the exception of:

- Exempt Staff who are members of the President's Cabinet;
- Exempt Staff who report directly to a member of the President's Cabinet;
- Exempt Staff who are represented by Faculty Senate; and
- Exempt Staff who are classified as Executives.

You may submit a self-nomination or nominate another eligible Staff member; details for nomination statements are included in the following form.



#### **Employee Assistance Program**


