This seminar will examine the social, cultural and political themes embedded in contemporary science fiction, focusing on the series, *Stranger Thing*, and Stephen King's novel, *IT*, as well as episodes from *Supernatural* and *The X Files*. Class discussion, supplemented, by short lecture, is the primary mode of instruction. The course is writing intensive.
