Office of Multicultural Services and Programs

Opened October 1, 2015, the Office of Multicultural Services and Programs (MSP) was created to advocate across various vectors to grow Indiana State University into a model of multicultural excellence for all who learn, live, and work on campus. MSP strives to build a climate of inclusion and community and aim to enhance intercultural competency through workshops, services, resources, programs, and influencing ISU policies and practices. We work actively with and for all Indiana State University students.

What does Multicultural really mean?

Multiculturalism involves an understanding, empathy, and appreciation of others language, religion, sexuality, age, mental or physical abilities, experiences, etc. To put simply, let's just say multiculturalism is the appreciation of other people. This includes things about the person that are not apparent – aspects of the person that you cannot see. When meeting someone, must take into consideration that every person comes with different abilities, values, norms, goals, and experiences. We are not all alike and we should appreciate those differences. We may share the same aspects of a particular culture (i.e. language, religion, gender, political affiliation, national origin); however, no one has shared the same experiences or influences throughout their lives.

If a student has a complaint/grievance with faculty, they may complete the Student Complaint/Grievance Form.

Sycamores Care is a campus wide program that cares for students in distress. It operates within the Dean of Students office and collaborates with all ISU departments in helping our students. We work closely with faculty, staff, students, and their families in demonstrating a caring culture so students know they are an important part of the ISU community.

Family members, fellow students, faculty, staff, and employers can make a referral to Sycamores Care. You may refer yourself too. Our team will contact the referred student and find the help they need.

Some of the areas students are referred for:

- Homesickness
- Family emergency
- Illness
- Academic problems
- Financial problems
- Injuries and hospitalization
- Feeling lost

- Faculty concerns regarding student’s change in behavior
- Relationship violence (see below)
- Questions in general

Victim Advocate

These services include but are not limited to: providing direction and intervention for students in emergency and non-emergency situations, coordinating victim services, working with University staff and faculty to resolve student problems; mediating and resolving conflicts; student referrals; and serving as the lead victim advocate for the university.

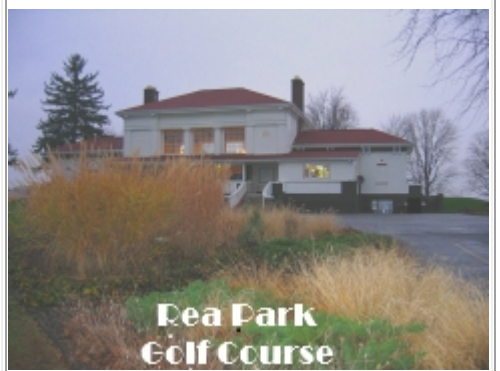
