In each of our buildings we have specially trained student staff called Social Justice Educators who focus on helping with identity exploration and development and to help in terms of working with others who are different. We understand we have students from communities where most people are the same, so coming here there could be some culture shock. We want to help students engage with so many different people who you will see living under one roof.

Each floor has a Resident Assistant who will make sure the floors are safe, but also do events specifically for your students' area. If your student is struggling to get involved, their RA is a great resource to use to help as a guide.

Front desk staff are a helpful and friendly resource who stationed at the front desk in the main lobby of each residence hall or apartment office. We have night time desk coverage in addition to staff doing rounds throughout the buildings. All our residence halls are card swipe secure at the outside doors. Front desk staff are trained to help with questions, mail and packages, but also to look out for suspicious behavior.

We also 3 types of professional staff:

Assistant Hall Directors are graduate students living and working in each residence hall. They address escalated conflicts in the communities and supervise some aspects of the student staff and things going on in the building.

Hall Coordinators are staff who have completed their master's degree and who help enforce policies and work with the student staff, as well as our residential curriculum.

Area Coordinators are the top level of staff in our buildings. They help develop the residential curriculum, supervise staff and manage processes within 2 to 3 buildings.

Move-In

As we keep an eye on the COVID situation the university is always looking at what is appropriate to help keep our students safe. We will continue to implement policies to mitigate the spread of COVID-19, your student should be on the lookout from an email by residential life for more information closer to move in. Sunday August 8th we do have some early arrival groups, but appointments will be happening that whole week of August 9th-14th for move in. Later on in the summer your student will receive an email about setting up an appointment in order to practice social distancing with move in.
