Questions/Concerns from staff:

1. More parking for CHHS building. More patrol for ticketing to ensure that permits are used.
2. Remote lots west of 3<sup>rd</sup> St – request for more lighting and blue lights.
  - Bryan explained that more lighting had been placed recently
3. Vehicles parking close to cross walks – especially on 5<sup>th</sup> Street.
  - We discussed yellow zone enforcement and I informed the group that I had already talked to Steve Culp about the construction vehicles parking in yellow zones (a big project was causing most of the issues).
4. More parking is needed on west side of campus. Walking across 3<sup>rd</sup> Street can be dangerous.
  - Michele stated that we had not received any reports concerning incidents on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and asked that if anyone did encounter a dangerous situation that they report it to our office for investigation.
5. Loading zones needed for 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Streets.
6. Pot holes on street by Lot I.
  - Bryan informed the group that this was a city street. He was to contact the city to inform them of the problem.

We discussed the change in garage permits and explained that Lot 5 was 1/3 full of students using garage permits.

Bryan discussed the shutdown of Lincoln quad planned for 2020.
