

## **Performing Arts Series Committee 2017-18 Report**

November 30, 2017

The Committee met at Hulman Center. We gave a brief Welcome and then did introductions and thanked those attending for participating. We discussed the mission of the PAS – to provide opportunities for students to be able to attend Performances that they might not have had the chance to attend in the past and to just generally enhance their student experience at ISU. We presented the different categories we have to look at when attempting to book shows...costs, routing, availability and how it fits in with our categorization of possible events. We passed out listing of Past Performances and then discussed the Current Season. We passed out evaluations and ask them to evaluate the shows that had already happened and then to comment on the upcoming shows. We then gave out a list of possible 2018-19 shows and asked them to comment and rank them in their preferred order.
