Board of Trustees Pass \$174

Indiana State University's Board of Trustees on Friday approved a \$174 million budget for the 2021-22 academic year.

The board also approved tuition rates and mandatory fees for 2021-22 and 2022-23.

The 1.4 percent increases are below the three-year compound annual growth rate of the Consumer Price Index for the Midwest Region. The CPI measures the change in prices of consumer goods and services.

ISU's tuition and mandatory fees for in-state students will increase by \$66 per semester in 2021-22 and \$67 per semester in 2022-23. Total tuition and mandatory fees for in-state students will be \$9,598 in 2021-22 and \$9,732 in 2022-23. That is the lowest in the state for four-year public universities with a statewide mission.

"We're pleased to present a balanced budget while continuing Indiana State University's history of affordable tuition and high-quality education," ISU President Dr. Deborah J. Curtis said.


