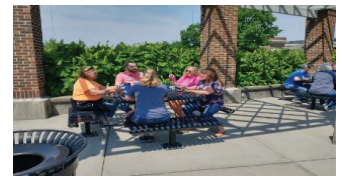
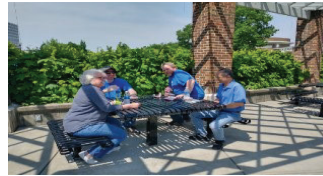

In the Blue Box labeled ISU Students and Staff enter the access code: ISU and then press select.

Follow the instructions on the pages and select which volunteer job you want to assist with. You must make a selection in fields that are required.

After you have selected your shifts press NEXT and follow the instructions to either log-in to your existing account, or, if this is your first time volunteering, create an account. You will then fill out your user profile – please be sure to answer the fields that ask for your ISU ID # and for Group or Organization enter how you are affiliated with ISU (for example: Staff, Football Team, HHS student).

After you register you will receive a confirmation email. If you do not receive one, please check your spam or junk folder as your security settings might have filtered the email. Register by **May 16th** to receive a race shirt

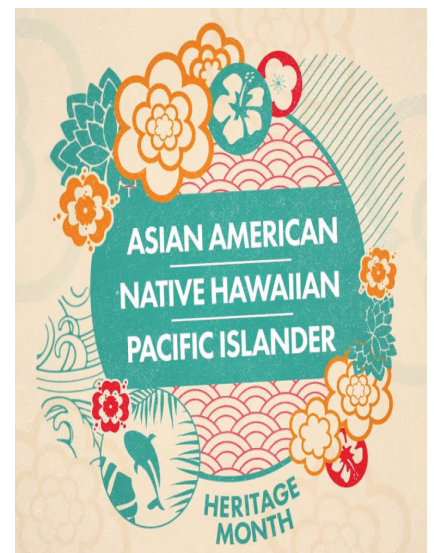


