The Academic Procession

The academic regalia, which adds interest and color to the Commencement procession, is as old in history as are universities—that is, more than eight hundred years old. The academic hood, which is worn as an adornment today, served a practical purpose in days of unheated classrooms and cold sleeping quarters.

During the traditional academic procession, the gown and hood indicate the degree held by the wearer or the one about to be received. The hood is lined with the official color or colors of the college or university conferring the degree. Graduates of certain institutions wear gowns in the color of the university. The doctoral gown is faced down the front with velvet panels and has three velvet crossbars on each sleeve. The velvet may be black or may be the color which represents the field in which the degree was conferred.

Since the degrees earned by the faculty of Indiana State University represent many colleges and universities in the United States and abroad, with a wide range of degree fields, the variety of attire forms a bright and colorful pattern.

The Commencement processional of faculty symbolizes recognition for their contributions to the University through awards, faculty rank, and years of service. It begins with full professors/librarians, followed by associate professors/associate librarians, assistant professors/assistant librarians, and ends with instructors, each group arranged according to their years of service.

Commencement Attire

Doctoral Degree

Holders of or candidates for doctoral degrees from Indiana State University wear blue robes with black velvet facing down the front and three crossbars of the same color on the bell-shaped sleeves.

Hoods are blue, lined with blue satin with white satin chevrons and are edged with velvet trim in colors related to the discipline.

- Doctor of Athletic Training—Sage green
- Doctor of Health Science—Hunter green
- Doctor of Nursing Practice—Apricot
- Doctor of Philosophy—Dark blue
- Doctor of Physical Therapy—Teal matinee
- Doctor of Psychology—Gold

Candidates may wear a black tam with gold tassel.

chevrons and are edged with velvet trim in colors related to the discipline.

Undergraduate Degree

Indiana State University bachelor’s degree holders or candidates wear a blue gown and a blue mortarboard with a blue and white tassel.

Honors College

Graduates of the Honors College wear blue hoods, edged in black velvet, lined with blue satin with white satin chevrons.

Commencement Mace

A Commencement mace has been carried in every Commencement ceremony since 1966. The original mace was a gift to Professor Caleb Mills, State Superintendent of Public Instruction in Indiana from 1854-1857. Mills, who earned the title of “Father of Public Education,” was instrumental in the establishment of Indiana State Normal School—now Indiana State University. The original mace was actually a walking cane decorated with blue and white silk ribbons representing the school’s colors.

The original mace was replaced in 2010. A new mace was designed and produced by Mark Joseph Clauss, mechanical technologist and lecturer in ISU’s Bailey College of Engineering and Technology. The mace is made of cherry hardwood with a replica of the University’s Presidents Medallion embedded at the top. The medallion is a four-inch gold medal with 36 blue sapphire gemstones and the official University seal at the center.

Scholarship Honors

Those students graduating with a scholarship index of 3.90 or higher will be graduated Summa Cum Laude. Those with a scholarship index between 3.70 and 3.89 will be graduated Magna Cum Laude. Those with a scholarship index between 3.50 and 3.69 will be graduated Cum Laude. Recognition of these special honors will be made in appropriate fashion at the Commencement ceremonies and on the diplomas.

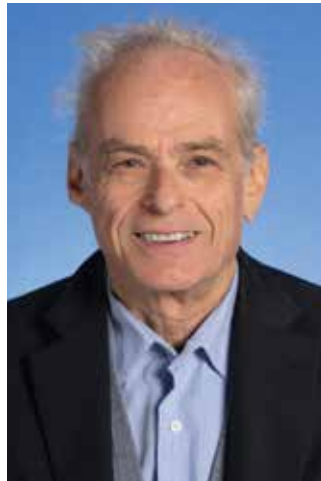

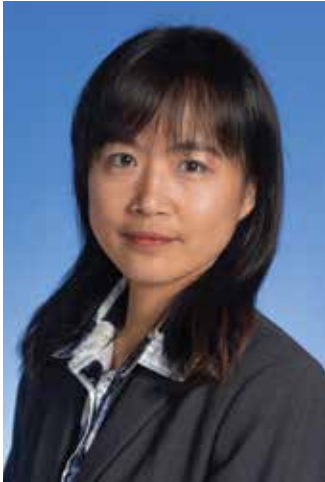

Kimberly Grace Collins

Kimmie Collins, a lifelong Sycamore from Terre Haute, Indiana, is graduating with a Master of Arts in Communication, with a concentration of Sales Management. She is Vice President of Lambda Pi Eta, the Honor Society for the National Communication Association. Her research project, "May I have the Definition of Culture?"



Co-Constructing Camaraderie and Competition at the Scripps National Spelling Bee," explores how Scripps National Spelling Bee participants create a collaborative organizational culture amidst fierce competition.

Through the McKee Fellowship, Collins fulfilled her dream of writing and publishing a children's book about Sycamore Sam entitled *Sam Becomes a Sycamore*. She and Sycamore Sam read the book at local schools, providing each second grader a book to foster their love of reading and Indiana State. Collins' book is available through the ISU Bookstore and Amazon. She is eager to continue writing children's books.

During her studies, Collins was a graduate assistant in Rose-Hulman's Office of Communications and Marketing, where she wrote feature stories and created social media content. Collins also returns to the Scripps National Spelling Bee's social media team each year.

Appointed by the governor, Collins served as Student Trustee on Indiana State University's Board of Trustees from 2021 to 2023. She earned a Bachelor's degree in Marketing with a Minor in Entrepreneurship from Indiana State in 2022.

Passionate about education, Collins hopes to spend her career telling people's stories to make a difference in students' lives.

Alumni Speaker

Gregory Bierly

Dr. Gregory Bierly was born and raised in the tiny town of Elizabeth in southeastern Indiana near the Ohio River. He graduated from South Central High School and went on to study physical geography and climatology in the Geography and Geology Department at Indiana State University. There Bierly earned a Bachelor's of Science degree and a Master's of Arts degree under the direction of Dr. John Harrington. He then earned his Ph.D. from Michigan State University, where he was a research assistant in synoptic meteorology and mid-latitude cyclone climatology with Dr. Julie Winkler.



Bierly joined the faculty of Indiana State University in 1995, where he directed the climatology laboratory and taught environmental science, weather and climate, and synoptic meteorology to thousands of students in the Department of Earth and Environmental Systems. Bierly became the director of the University Honors Program in 2006, and guided its growth and development to become Indiana State's first Honors College; he now serves as dean to a college of over 1,000 honors students.

During his time at ISU, Bierly has also served as a faculty senator, a fellow for Community Engagement, and Chief Research Officer. He was presented the President's Medal for Exemplary Teaching and Scholarship in 2012, and the William Albert Jones medal in 2017. He is currently a member of the Board of Directors for the Terre Haute Symphony Orchestra.

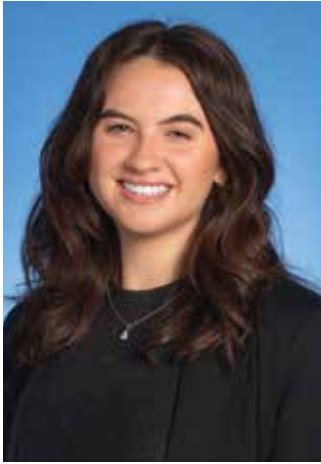

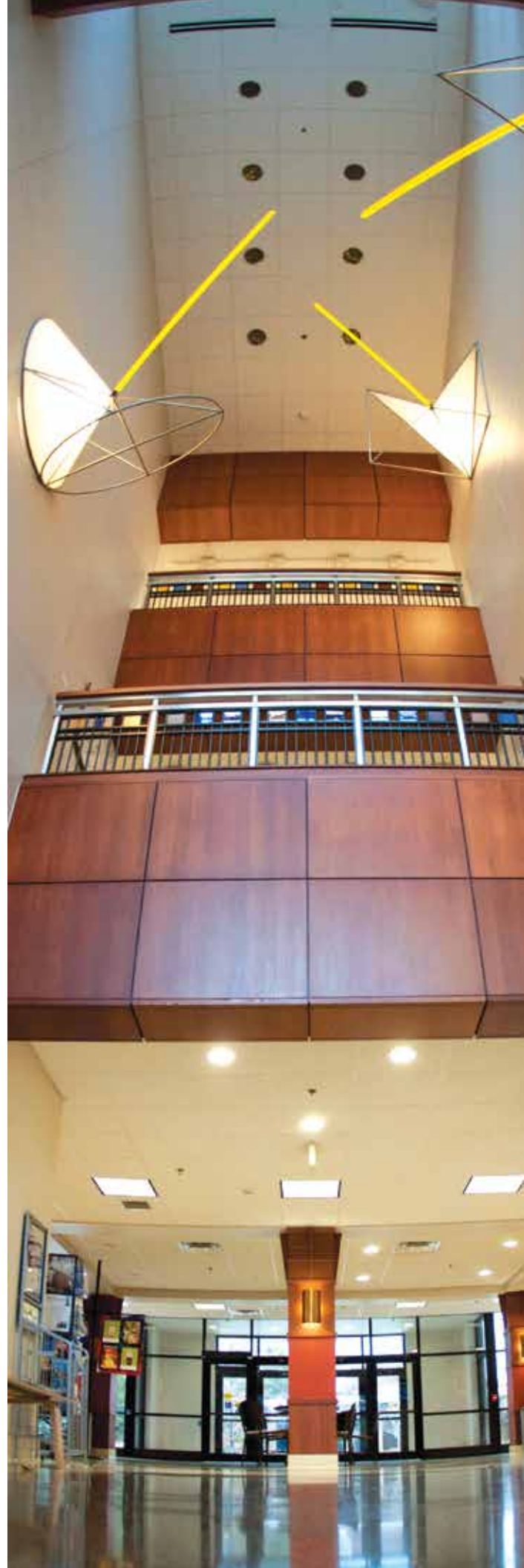


