

Voter Registration Deadlines and Election Dates

Deadline to Register to Vote in Indiana: **October 9, 2018**

General Election: **November 6, 2018**

Register at School or Home

- You have to be registered in the county for which you want to vote.
- You have a choice about where to register vote: register with campus address or choose to register (or remain registered) at permanent home address.

How to Register to Vote/Check Voter Registration Status/Get Election Information

- Use TurboVote via the portal or indstate.turbovote.org—takes 2 minutes to complete the voter registration application.

Choose Voting Location

- If you want to vote at the ISU vote center on Election Day, then you have to be registered to vote in Vigo County (visit indstate.turbovote.org for help with this).
- If you want to vote in a different county, you will need to vote early or on Election Day in that county, or get an absentee ballot sent to you at school (visit indstate.turbovote.org for help with this).

Needed on Election Day

- In Indiana you will need a valid state-issued ID. An ISU ID will work.

Common Questions and Concerns

Will changing my voter registration affect my financial aid or if I can be claimed as a dependent by my parents?

- No, where you register to vote has no impact on financial aid or your parents' ability to claim you as a dependent on their taxes or insurance.

Will voter registration impact my driver's license or car registration?

- No, where you register to vote does not have any impact on your driver's license or car registration.

Does voter registration influence out-of-state tuition status?

- No, there is no connection between tuition status and voter registration.

I don't know much about the election, so maybe I shouldn't vote.
